Below is a list of approved non-prescription topical products that the school nurse may need to apply on your child's skin during the school year. They are easily found in a drugstore for relief or prevent minor skin irritations.

Please check all that are allowed to be applied if needed.

- Hand Sanitizer**
- Aveeno Lotion**
- Sunscreen** \* *I also give consent to my child's teacher to apply the sunscreen.* \_\_\_\_\_
- Antibiotic Ointment** (*Neosporin/Bacitracin*)
- Desitin Cream** (*zinc oxide 40%, for diaper rash*)
- Aquaphor** (*to prevent diaper rash, for chapped lips, dry skin, etc.*)
- Hydrocortisone 1% Ointment** (*for temporary relief of itching*)
- Antifungal Cream** (*for athlete's foot, jock itch and ringworm*)
- First Aid Antiseptic and Pain Reliever Liquid** (*Bactine/Band-aid, used to clean minor cuts, scrapes and burns, also contains 2% Lidocaine for temporary pain relief*)

Please be assured that the nurse will contact you before applying anything on your child if the situation calls for it.

If you prefer specific brands to be used on your child, especially the sunscreen, please provide the product or inform your child's teacher or the nurse.
